
ENCRYPTED EMAIL EXAMPLE

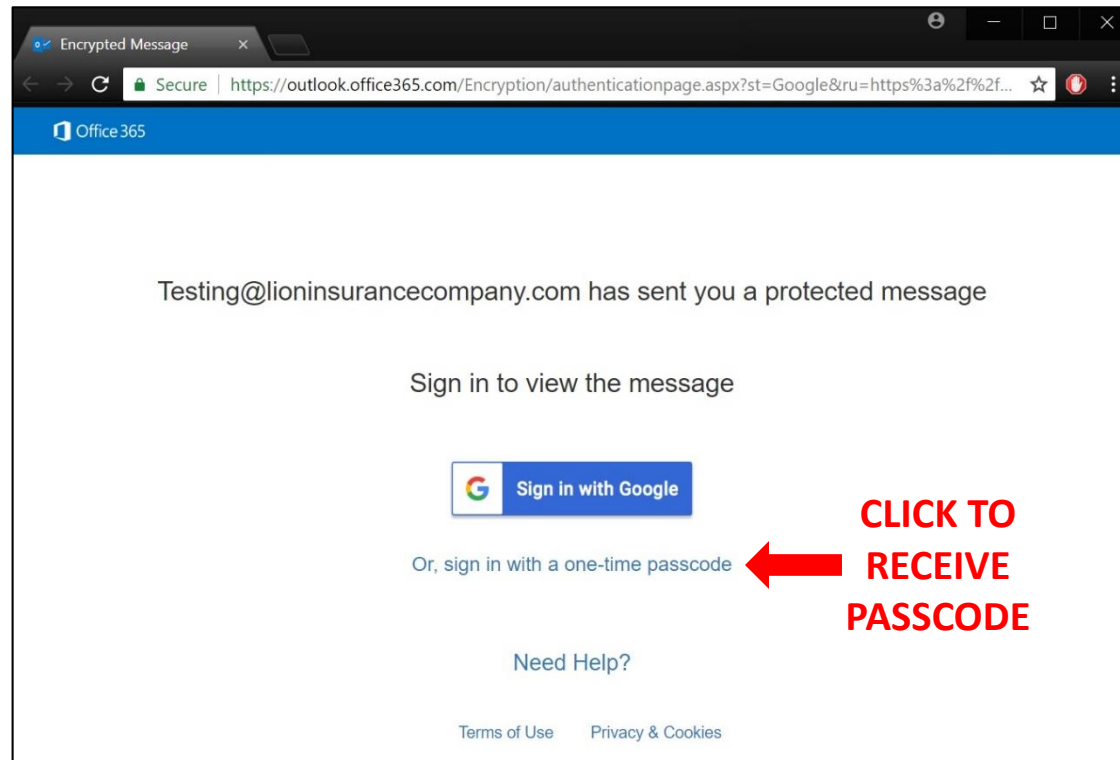


